What is the ProRef program?

The "Program for the Academic Preparation and Integration of Refugees" (ProRef) at the Europa-Universität Flensburg (EUF) supports refugees who are interested in studying at higher education institutions.

Through language and key competence courses as well as study, career and social counseling, the EUF facilitates integration into the German higher education system, the labor market and society.

The ProRef program includes

- academically oriented German and English language courses at levels B2-C1
- recognized language examinations (German/English)
- accompanying courses consisting of four key competence modules: methodological competence, social and personal competence, cultural competence, media and IT competence
- · Individual study, career and social counseling
- support in finding accommodation, applying for studies and applying for BAföG
- guest auditor status: free use of the university infrastructure and attendance of lectures and seminars
- possibility to obtain the statewide semester ticket for Schleswig-Holstein and Hamburg
- · course excursions, events and campus tours
- CampusFRIENDS a buddy program without borders!
 Exchange program between ProRef participants and enrolled students
- extracurricular activities: cultural events and social activities

How does the program work?

Phase 1: Summer School

- refresher courses in German at the levels B1+/B2+ or English at level B1+
- key competence modules (methodological competence, social and personal competence, cultural competence, media and IT competence)

Phase 2: Fall semester

- four-month language course in German at levels B2/C1 or English at level B2
- courses from the four key competence modules

Phase 3: Winter School

- two-month language course in German at levels B2/C1 or English at level B2
- courses from the four key competence modules

Phase 4: Spring semester

- four-month language course in German or English at level C1
- \cdot courses from the four key competence modules

Who can apply?

You can apply for the ProRef program if you

- have a refugee background
- have a university entrance qualification (Hochschulzugangsberechtigung)
- have language skills in German or English at least at level B1
- would like to start studying after the end of the program

EUF students with a refugee background can also participate in individual language courses and/or key competence modules.

Application documents

Please enclose all relevant language and educational certificates with your online application. Certificates in the original language must also be submitted in a German or English translation (by sworn translators).

Missing language certificates

If you do not have a language certificate, you can take a language placement test in German and/or English at the EUF.
